## (DBC) ICE CREAM PACKAGING

Packages can be recycled in the same manner as other paperboard products such as cereal boxes, frozen food boxes, etc. When the product is recycled, the fibre is reclaimed and made into other paper products.

The coating dissolves and is removed in the same manner as other ingredients such as printing inks and varnishes. DBC provides all of the same properties such as moisture and oxygen barriers as a regular polyethylene ice cream package. A recycling symbol can be used if the product is being recycled in more than 60% of the area that the product is sold. DBC ice cream packaging can also be composted in a industrial composting facility.
